Dr. Zhang received a Masters Degree in molecular pathology and a Doctor of Medicine (MD) degree in clinical medicine from Guangdong Medical University. He completed post-doctoral training at Harvard University Medical School. Dr. Zhang served as an assistant professor, instructor and pathologist in the Pathology Department of Guangdong Medical University, Research Scientist in the Environmental & Radiology Department of Colorado State University, Principal Scientist, Wound Healing Consultant and Division Head at Sinclair Research Center - Altasciences (CRO). His academic career involved research projects granted by the Chinese NHC, state strategic projects, and grants from NIH, NASA, and DOE of the United States.

Dr. Zhang's research disciplines include pathology, oncology, toxicology, wound healing, novel drug development and toxicology assessment. He has over 16 years of experience with clinical and biomedical research and academic teaching; 15 years of experience in the development of novel drugs, preclinical studies for toxicity, DMPK, and toxicokinetic evaluations involving stem cells, biomolecules, vaccines, small molecules and medical devices.
